Assistant Camp Leader - 4 positions

Volunteering as an Assistant Camp Leader at Sports Camp JUNAK is an excellent way to learn about our programs while working with youth and children. Sports School Junak organizes and provides sports activities, ski school, outdoor activities and summer sport camps for youth 6-12 in the Serbian community. In order to preserve the Serbian language, tradition, and culture, participants are totally immersed in the Serbian language in all our programs.

Requirements for High School Volunteer Camp Leader Assistants

- High school volunteers must be entering grades 10, 11, or 12 or have graduated high school in June 2016.
- Fluent in Serbian
- Volunteers must submit a cover letter and resume stating their interest in becoming a volunteer with Sports School Junak. Applications are due no later than Friday June 15, 2018 by 4:00pm.
- Volunteers older than 18 years must obtain and provide a clean and current within one year of September 2017 criminal record checks with vulnerable sector screening.

Volunteer Duties

- Lunch supervision
- Prep camp materials and sports equipment
- Be able to swim and accompany the staff and campers into pools or lakes
- Co-lead some activities
- Assist campers in completing activities and tasks
- Day trip bus supervision and escort campers around the campus when needed
- Develop a positive, fun, and safe camp environment for children and youth
- Monitor camper behaviour to ensure all camper safety and rules/regulations are followed
- Develop games, crafts, and activities for lunch supervision and during camps
- Other volunteer duties as assigned
